



**INDEMNITY/DECLARATION FORM**

**Cullinan Diamond Mine (Pty) Ltd (“CDM”) is regulated by the Mine Health & Safety Act 29 of 1996. This legislation requires CDM and its employees to identify hazards and eliminate, control, and minimise the risk relating to health and safety (“risks”) at the mine. These risks have been identified and for purposes of your visitation, have been duly explained to you. To this end you are required to comply with all instructions given by CDM.**

**In light of the above, neither CDM, nor its affiliated or associated companies, its directors nor its employees, will be held liable for any loss or damage to the property of any guest, visitor or other person on its premises, whether the damage or loss is a result of theft or otherwise, nor shall they be held responsible nor liable in any way for personal injury or harm, however caused, to guests, visitors or other persons or their children on its premises.**

**DISCLOSURES:**

- 1.1 I enter the property of CDM at my own risk, at my own free will, and not under any duress to do so.
- 1.2 The risk of entering an operating mine has been explained to me by my tour operator and I fully appreciate the nature of the risk associated with the undertaking of activities leading over uneven terrain, walking over uneven ground and my proximity to mining activities and outdoor conditions.
- 1.3 I acknowledge that I participate in the tour voluntarily and at my sole discretion and CDM cannot exercise any control whatsoever over the negligent or wilful acts or omissions of the other parties participating in the tour activities.
- 1.4 I have been advised and it is recorded that I shall be fully entitled to decline to participate in any of the tour activities at my absolute own discretion.
- 1.5 Whilst on the property of CDM, I shall obey all lawful instructions and requirements of the representatives of the Mine and the Tour Operator.
- 1.6 In my personal capacity, I hereby waive all claims against CDM, its associated companies, employees and directors and further indemnify them from the loss or damage to any goods or any injury or death during the course of my participation in the tour activities.
- 1.7 If under 18 years of age, I confirm that a legal guardian signed this document on my behalf and proof thereof has been provided to CDM.

***Please note that no person under the age of 12 will be allowed on the mine. At least one (1) tour guide and one (1) teacher per group of 30 (or fewer) children are required. Adult tour groups require one (1) tour guide per group of 45 (or fewer) adults.***

**EMERGENCY PRECAUTIONS:**

1. All buildings are equipped with fire alarms/fire horns. When an alarm is raised it is an indication of a fire within the building, and each visitor will evacuate the area, following the Tour guide to the nearest assembly point.
2. Emergency evacuation signs should be followed and no running or pushing should take place as these increase the risk of personal injury.
3. Do not attempt to extinguish a fire. CDM employees are trained to extinguish/contain fires.
4. All visitors are to remain at the converging point or area of safety until roll call has been taken and the responsible mine official (host) has accounted for you.

**HSE RULES:**

1. Wear the correct Personal Protective Clothing at all times and prescribed and handed over to you.



2. Stay with the tour operator and do not wander off into areas unknown to you.
3. Never walk in areas unaccompanied.
4. Do not touch or approach any machinery or equipment.
5. No smoking in vehicles, buildings or any area other than marked designated areas.
6. No alcohol/drugs are allowed onto CDM, and consumption of such items is prohibited whilst on the property of the Mine.
7. Use the three-point contact method when using stairs, where required.
8. Do not litter, please use the waste bins provided to discard personal waste.
9. No texting or talking on a cellphone while walking is permitted. In case of an emergency, please be in a stationary position when talking on a cellphone.
10. No running is allowed on mine; walk briskly should you need to.

**SECURITY RULES:**

1. Alcohol screening is compulsory at CDM.
2. The use of cameras or the taking of photos on smartphone devices is **strictly** limited to the Tourism Display Room, the mock tunnel and the viewpoint. No photos may be taken outside of these areas or of/with/by employees.
3. Entry/Exit to the mining area must be done through the main entry/exit points.
4. No contraband, for example, dangerous weapons, firearms, knives, explosives or electrical appliances are allowed into the mining area/premises.
5. Security personnel have the authority to search any person upon entering or exiting the Mine, it is considered an offence to refuse this.
6. Do not climb over, under, or through any security fence or throw any object over the security fence.
7. When approached to remove any parcel/item from the site, report the matter to the tour operator/security immediately.
8. It is strictly forbidden to sort, scratch, tamper or deliberately look for diamonds in any concentrate, kimberlite, ground or spillage within the mine premises.

**VISITOR DECLARATION:**
